

Sunshine Coast ElderCollege Registration Q & A

Frequently asked Questions(Q) and Answers(A)

1 Q: What is ElderCollege?

A: *ElderCollege is a community based program offering educational opportunities to Sunshine Coast residents aged 55+*

- The courses normally run three to five weeks with one two hour session per week. Courses are instructed by highly qualified volunteers from the community.
- The classes are a chance to increase your knowledge and keep your mind active. There are no exams, homework or assignments.

2 Q: Where are classes held?

A: *Most classes are held at the Capilano University Sechelt Campus, see map on next page (Note there is NO registration at the CapU Campus!)*

- Others are held at various places in the community – the location is listed with the course description on line and in the SCRD Recreation Guide.

3 Q: Where do I find info about the ElderCollege Courses?

A: *You find the list of courses on the Sunshine Coast ElderCollege web site: <http://sunshinecoasteldercollege.ca/> in the SCRD Recreation Guide, (available in your mailbox, mid August) or on the one page summary handout.*

4 Q: Where can I register for the ElderCollege Courses?

A: *You can register, 4 different ways:*

- In Person at the Sechelt Aquatic Centre
- In Person at the Gibsons and Area Community Centre
- In Person at the Pender Harbour Aquatic and Fitness Centre
- On-Line via the SCRD Website www.scrd.ca/activities . There is also a link on the Sunshine Coast ElderCollege website that will take you directly to the SCRD registration page.

5 Q: What is the cost of the ElderCollege courses?

A: *All courses are now \$35 + GST = \$36.75 total*

6 Q: *Where and how can I pay for the courses?*

A: *You can pay as follows:*

- At the Sechelt Aquatic Centre
- At the Gibsons and Area Community Centre
- At the Pender Harbour Aquatic and Fitness Centre

With Visa, MasterCard, Debit Card, Cash or Recreation Gift Certificates

- Or Online

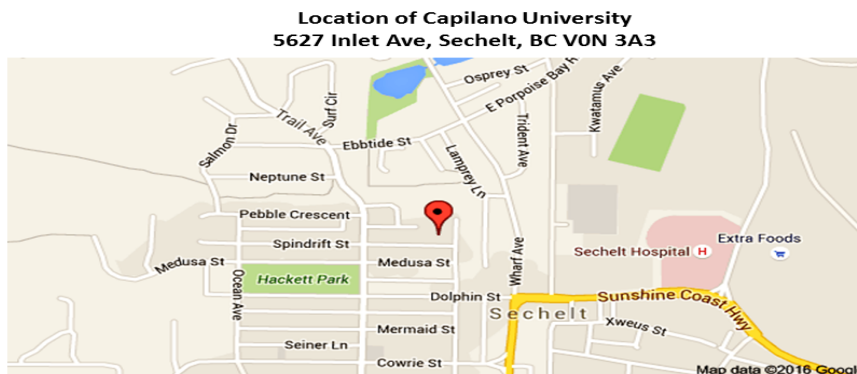
With Visa or MasterCard.

7 Q: *What do I need at the time of Registration?*

A: *The name of the course you are interested in taking*

- Have your form of payment ready.
- If you want to register Online you need to also have your SCR D Recreation Account name and log-in info ready.
- If you do not have an existing SCR D Recreation Account, you need to first open an account – it's easy and it's free at www.scrd.ca/activities

Please note there is NO registration at the Capilano University Campus!
